



EHANCING MEMBERS' COMMITMENT TO STAKEHOLDER PLATFORMS

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OBJECTIVE OF A MULTI-STAKEHOLDER PLATFORM (SP) IN A RESEARCH PROJECT:

- to consult potential users, beneficiaries of the research and citizens affected by the impact of the implementation of the results from an early stage during the whole project;
- to ensure that their needs and priorities are properly considered during the design and implementation of the research task;
- to get their advice to improve the practical applicability of results;
- to understand their resources, capabilities and constraints for using the results;
- to improve the relevance, increase the impact;
- to disseminate the results.

CHALLENGES

- to attract appropriate members representing different steps of different related value chains - ready to participate and contribute;
- to maintain their interest and contribution during the whole project.

MEETING THE CHALLENGE

- Segmentation of the SP members and providing attractive offers for accessing, information, knowledge, methods, solutions, interactive learning, networking
- Involving the members of the SP and developing feeling of ownership;
 - Joint development of an action plan;
 - Implementing the action plan.

ACTION PLAN

- At start joint development of an action plan for SP activities and its proactive implementation in a partnership mood
 - Main objective of the action plan to facilitate involvement and engagement
 - facilitate consultation on the needs of the project partners and the stakeholders, dialogue/ exchange of knowledge and interactive learning from each other;
 - dissemination of the results;
 - catalyse exploitation of the results;
 - facilitate networking.

MAINTAINING INTEREST OF NOAW STAKEHOLDERS

- Combining web-based consultations and meetings in persons
- Web based information, consultations
 - joint development of an action plan
 - providing information / summary about the results of the project and/or state of art information,
 - research summary sheets,
 - webinars (recorded –available online),
 - project results + short summaries of presentations on conferences,
 - methods offered for testing, trial and use,
 - joint development of guidance materials on typical problems, on applicable solutions, technologies, good practices, typical failures/traps to be avoided using collaborative work spaces/file editors such as Google docs
 - web-based trainings
- meetings in person:
 - one to one meetings
 - meetings in person on the stakeholder events, workshops
- Facilitating networking
 - -providing a matchmaking forum members and project partners for future cooperation
